- 23 Sports
- More than 1,800 Student-Athletes Honored Each Year
- Typically nominated by conference offices (except sports where conference does not present that POW award)
- Key criteria for selection:

Game statistics (points/rebounds, goals/assists, etc.)

Quality of opponents (national rankings, etc.)

Team's performance (led team to victory, etc.)

Other factors (overtime/last second goal, game/career/school records)

## **All-Star Program**

- 10 Sports (Football, Field Hockey, M/W Basketball, M/W Hockey, Baseball, Softball, M/W Lacrosse)
- 76 Different All-Star Teams
- More than 700 Student-Athletes Honored Each Year
- ECAC All-Stars are selected from primary conference All-Star teams
- Nominated by individual school SIDs and voted on by the coaches

## **Awards Program**

- Nominated by SIDs Deadline is May 15
- Presented at Annual Convention in October
- More than 20 Student-Athletes, Administrators, Teams, Trainers, and Institutions Honored Each Year
- Robbins-Scholar Athlete Awards (Male/Female each division total of six)
- Jostens Male and Female Administrator of the Year
- Jostens Institution of the Year
- Turfer Athletic Rowing Trophy (combined men's and women's rowing program)
- Katherine Ley Award (female athletics administrator/role model for women's coaches and administrators)
- George Shiebler Award (outstanding official)
- Dr. Donald Grover Award (outstanding trainer)
- James Lynah Distinguished Achievement Awards (retired athletics administrators)
