

Set Your Own!

Choose Edit > Keyboard Shortcuts.

Click New Set to create a new shortcut set (*tell what set you want it to be based on*)

Product Area: Select the area containing the command you want to define or redefine.

Commands list: Select the command that you want to define or redefine.

New Shortcut box: Press the keys for your new keyboard shortcut.

Note: If the key sequence is currently being used for another command, InDesign displays that command under Current Shortcuts. You can choose to change the original shortcut also, or try another shortcut.

Tip: Do not assign single-key shortcuts to menu commands, they interfere with the typing of text!
