THE SID BOARD - A SHORT HISTORY

Back in the summer of 2006, Phil Ticknor the Sports Information Director at Washington College created The SID Board as a way for sports information professionals from all Divisions to discuss matters pertinent to the profession. Almost four years later, The SID Board has almost 850 members and growing.

WHAT IS THE SID BOARD?

The SID Board is a web site that allows sports information professionals to voice their opinion, thoughts and concerns about the comings and goings in the sports information field. You can throw an idea out there and a good chance people will give you their opinion on the matter. You can ask a question and there is a good chance you will get an answer...even on Christmas Day!! Signing up is easy, go to http://sid.proboards.com/ and sign-up. Phil Ticknor will approve of you and away you go posting on the board. As Ira Thor at New Jersey City University said in 2008, "it's like having a Town Hall Meeting 24 hours a day."

BENEFITS OF BEING ON THE SID BOARD

- Can throw ideas out and other people can chime in with their thoughts.
- Ask about StatCrew issues since Alex Grim and Monica Pellman are on here regularly.
