IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- Know your audience
 - Assume anyone and everyone is viewing your site, especially:
 - School and department administrators & coaches
 - Student-athletes & potential student-athletes/students
 - Alums & Parents
 - Media
 - Campus community & Area community members
 - Do not assume everyone has the know-how to navigate websites
 - o Do not assume everyone knows about athletics
 - Assume potential student-athletes/students and media use it as a resource so provide as much information as possible
- Keep the layout simple
 - o Nothing should be more than two clicks away
 - o Keep the bells and whistles such as introductory video messages to a minimum (not everyone has the computer and/or patience to support such things)
- Limit pop-ups and other things that may be distracting or annoying
- Let the experts assist you
 - o There are people with tremendous knowledge about the web on your campus. Use those folks as a resource.
 - There are many web companies that can simplify your life if you can afford to implement their system. Even if you cannot afford them, use their clients your colleagues as resources.
 - Do your homework before hiring someone
 - Ask colleagues who have gone through the process about their experiences (from soup to nuts)
- Take criticism constructively, not personally

 - Statistics
 - Photographs as many as possible, especially action
 - o Staff Directory
 - o Directions to school as well as athletic sites (on/off campus)
- The Should Haves
 - o Player/Coaches/Staff bios and head shots
 - Links
 - o Recruiting Form/Brochure
 - o Program/Media Guide
 - o Archives
 - o Hall of Fame
 - o Honors & Awards
- The Nice to Haves
 - o Community Service initiatives/photos
 - o Feature Stories

- Game Notes
- Records & History
- o Blogs
- o Camp Information
- o Alumni Information (Where are they now?)
